Combined Registration Set Up

The following guide will help you setup your security information which will be used for security verification or password reset or both based on the chosen method

Security verification versus password reset authentication

Security info methods are used for both Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and for Self Service Password Reset (SSPR). However, not all methods can be used for both.

Method	Used for
Authenticator app	Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and for Self Service Password Reset (SSPR)
Text messages	Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and for Self Service Password Reset (SSPR)
Phone calls	Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and for Self Service Password Reset (SSPR)
Email account	Self Service Password reset authentication only. You'll need to choose another method for Multi-Factor Authentication.

Optional: To prevent having to sign out of an existing o365 account, based on your browser, you can use a private or incognito window.

1. Go to <u>https://aka.ms/mfasetup</u> and Click Sign In using your NIU user ID (your <u>ZID@students.niu.edu</u> (for students) OR <u>AccountID@mail.niu.edu</u> (for other accounts)) and password

When your account has been enabled with MFA, you will be asked to provide more information to keep your account secure (Step 2)

For Retiree accounts for whom MFA is scheduled to be enabled on a later date, you can also pre-register your account here (Step 3)
